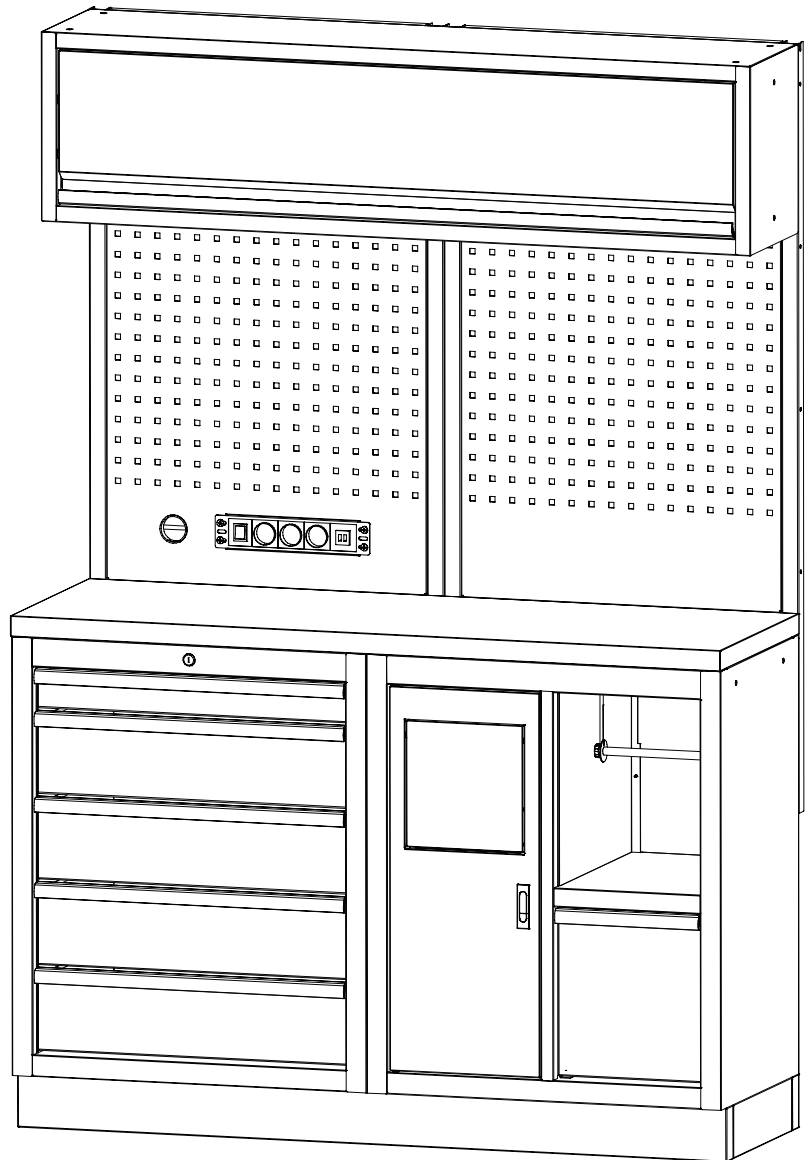
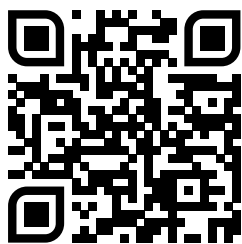

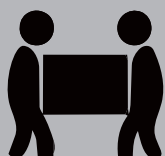
CHECK COMPONENTS

- Before assembling, confirm all parts have been supplied and are in good condition.
- If any parts are missing or damaged, do not assemble. Contact your supplier.



ASSEMBLY LOCATION

- Assemble on a clean, flat and level surface.
- Use a soft floor covering (e.g. carpet or blanket) to prevent scratches on painted surfaces.
- If assembling on a wooded floor, place a thin protective sheet or cloth on the floor.



LIFTING AND HANDLING

- Some components are heavy and bulky. Use two people or mechanical lifting aids where required.
- Do not attempt to lift heavy components alone.



PERSONAL PROTECTION

- Wear gloves during assembly to protect against sharp edges and pinch points.



KEEP AWAY

- Keep children, infants and pets away from the assembly area.
- This product contains small parts which may be a choking hazard.



TOOLS

- Use the correct tools as specified in the manual.
- Ensure tools are in good condition and used safely.



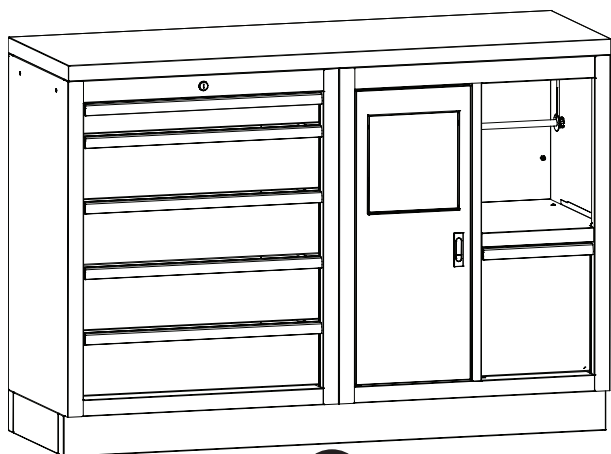
STABILITY

- When installed, secure the cabinet to a suitable wall or structure where required.

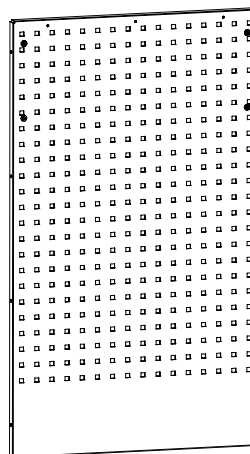

- 1** Attach **2x (E)** Base Front Panels & **4x (F)** Base Side Panels together as shown below using **16x (d)** Screws (ST6x12).

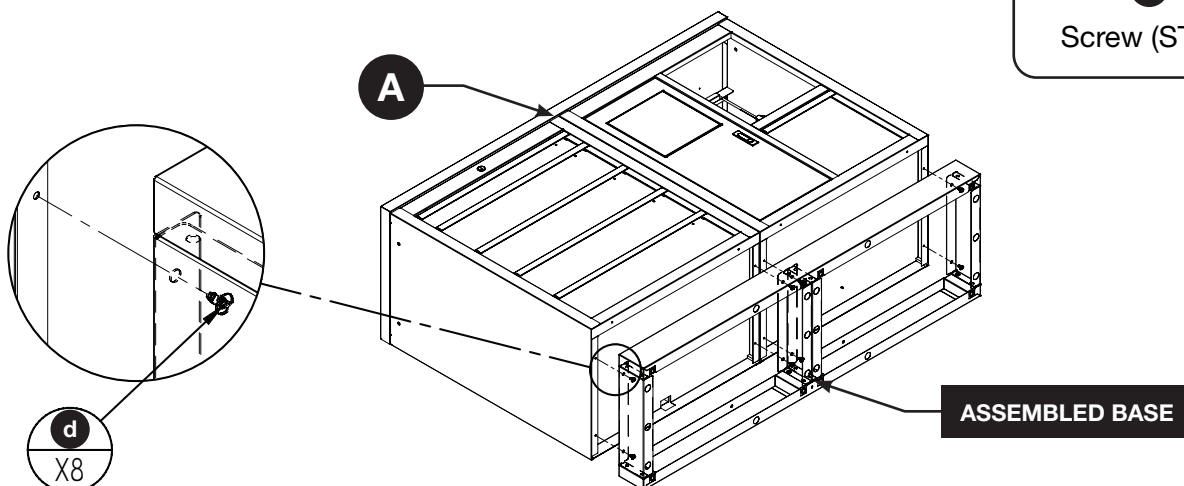

- 2** Attach **(A)** Base Cabinet to the assembled Base as shown below using **8x (d)** Screws (ST6x12).

Attach **4x (G)** Pillars to the rear of the base cabinet **(A)** as shown below using **9x (a)** Hex Bolts (M6x16) & **1x (b)** Nut (M6).

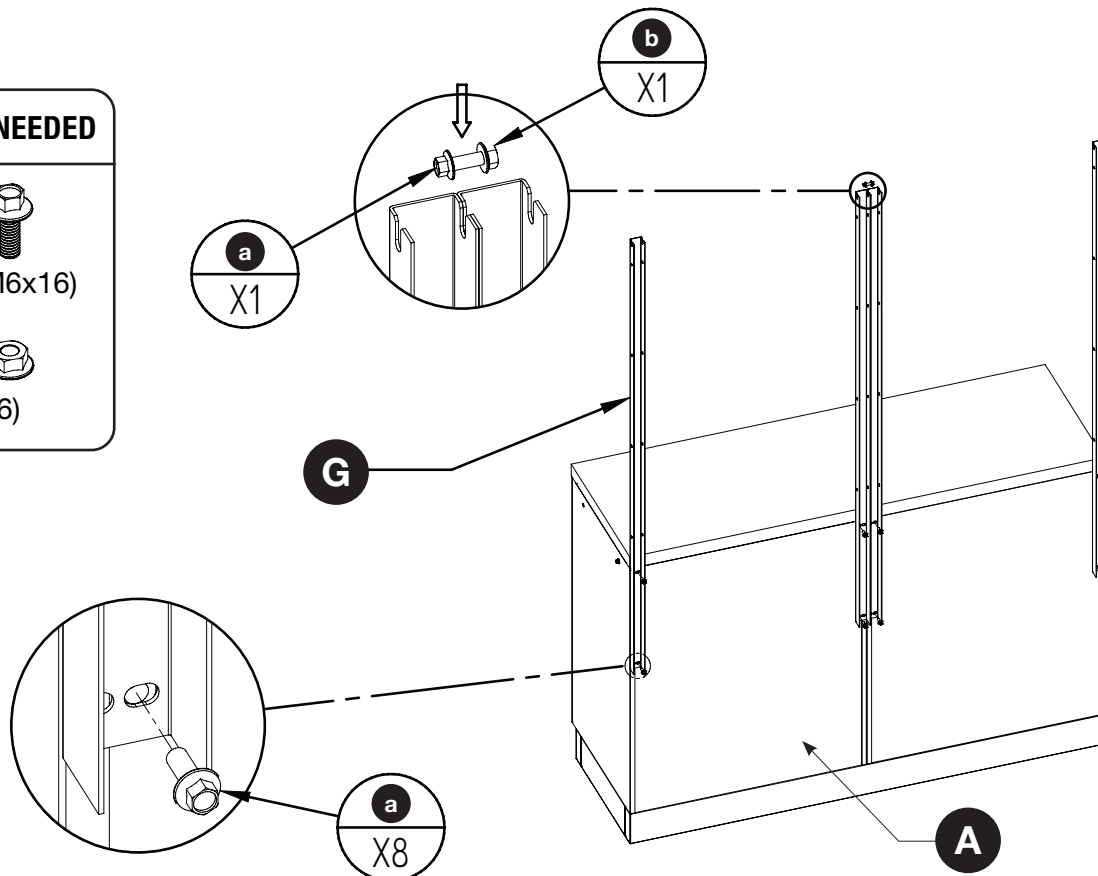

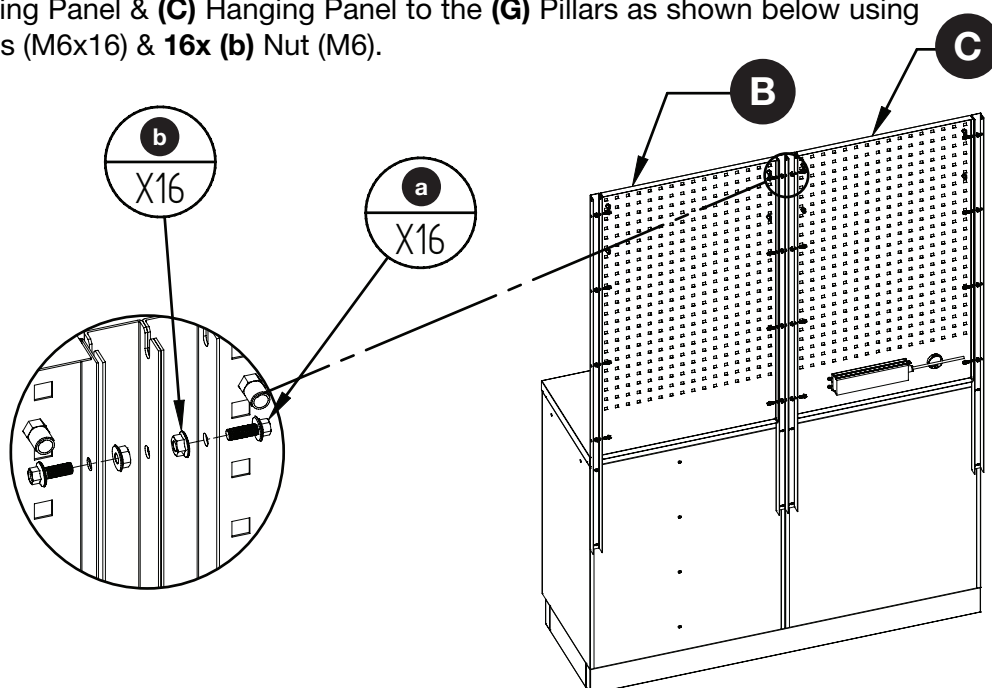

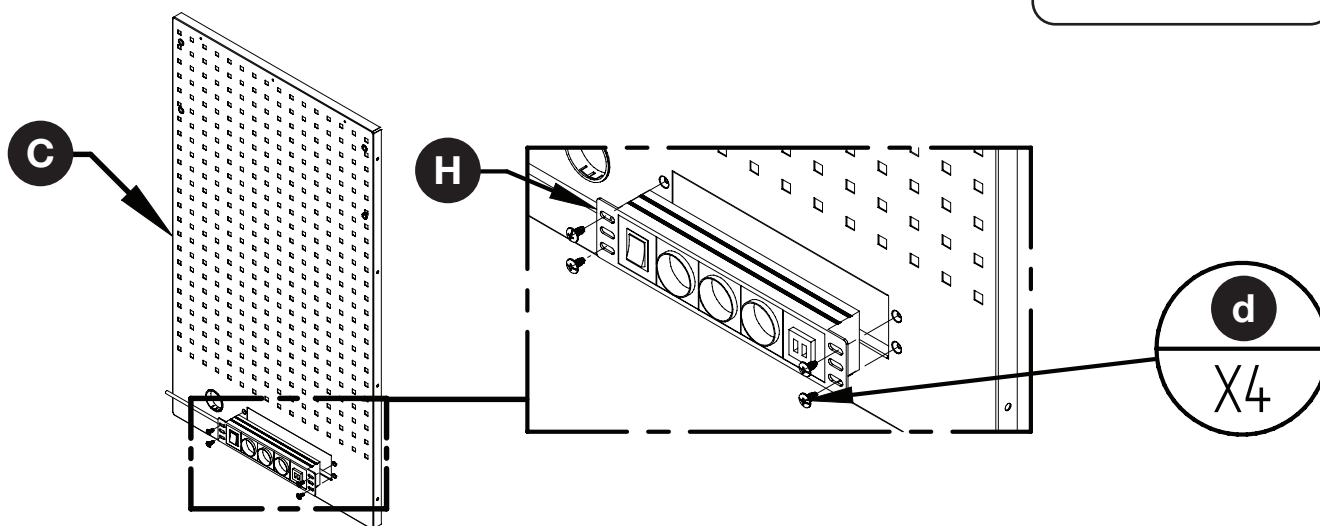

Attach the Power Strip (**H**) to the rear of Hanging Panel (**C**) as shown below using **4x (d)** Screws (ST6x12).

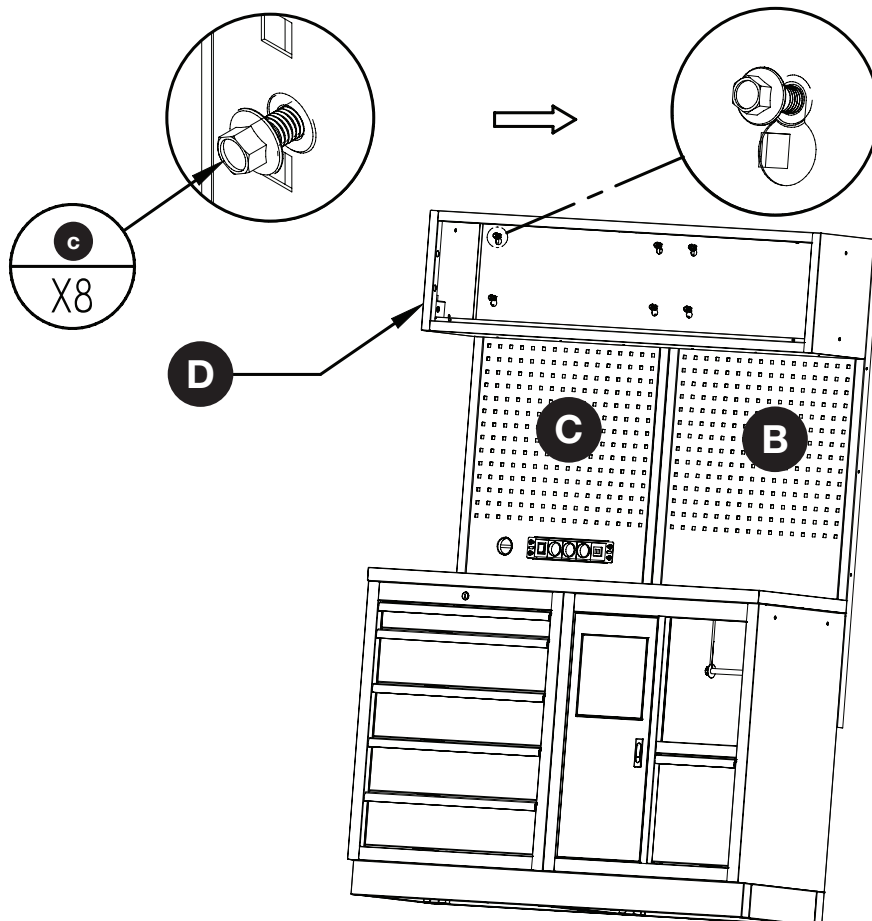

Screw in **8x (c)** Hex Bolts (M8x16) loosely into the Hanging Panels (**B & C**) as shown below then hang the pre-slotted backed Wall Cabinet (**D**) onto the **8x (c)** Hex Bolts (M8x16) and fasten in place.

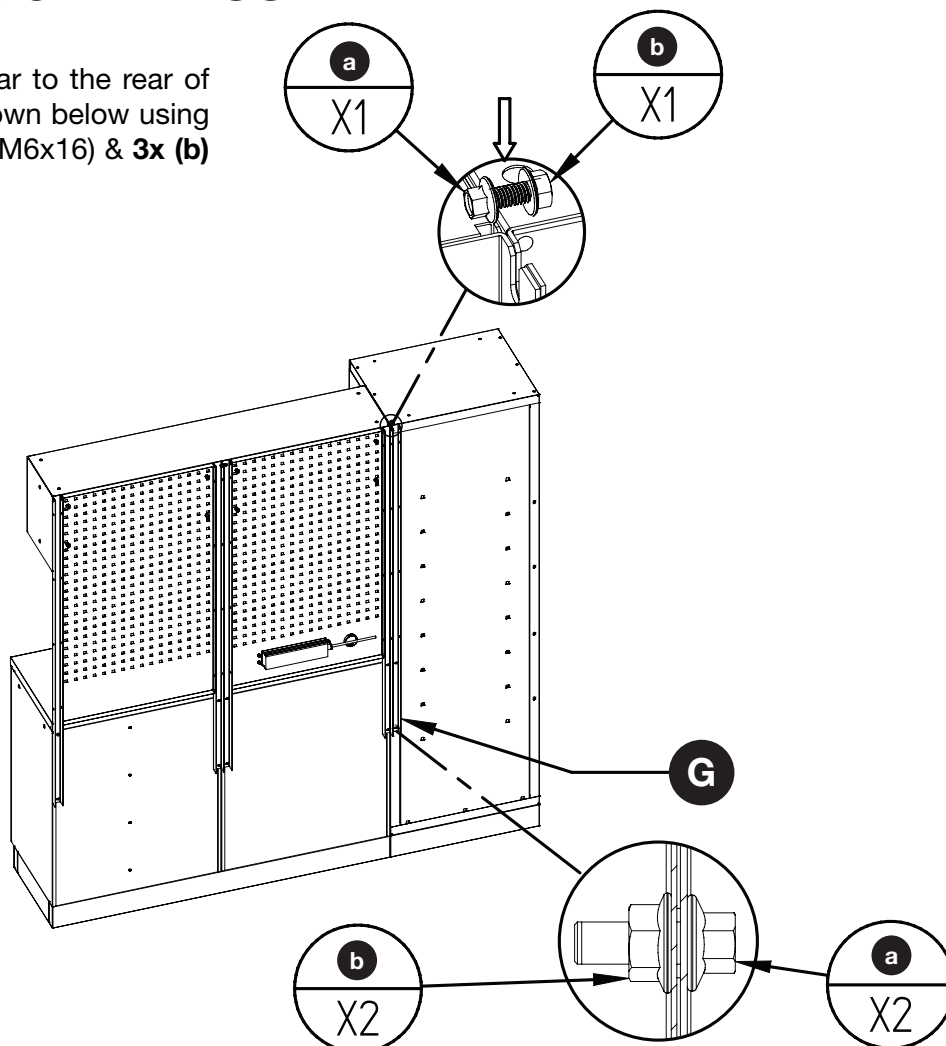
OPTIONAL LOCKER ASSEMBLY

- 7** Attach **1x (G)** Pillar to the rear of the Locker as shown below using **3x (a)** Hex Bolts (M6x16) & **3x (b)** Nuts (M6).

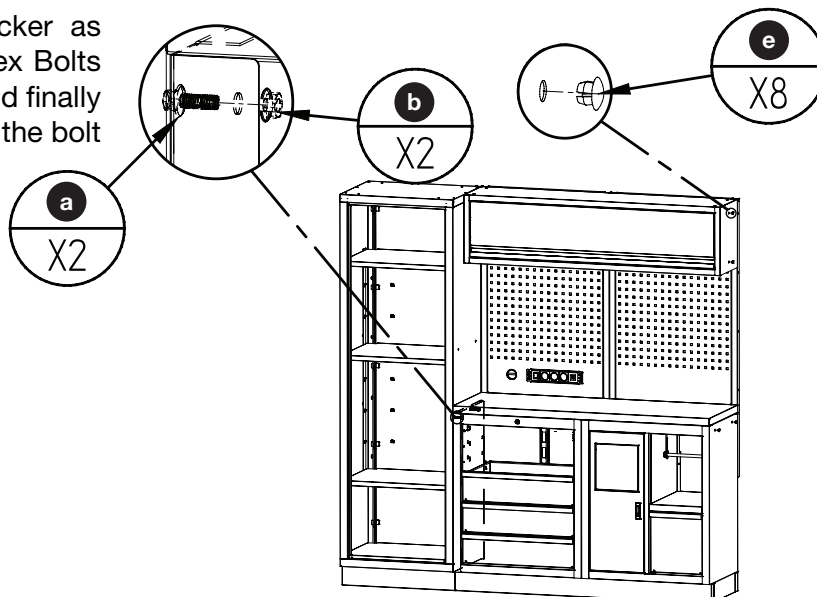
- 8** Secure the front of the Locker as shown below using **2x (a)** Hex Bolts (M6x16) & **2x (b)** Nuts (M6) and finally place **8x (e)** Plastic Pins over the bolt heads as shown below.

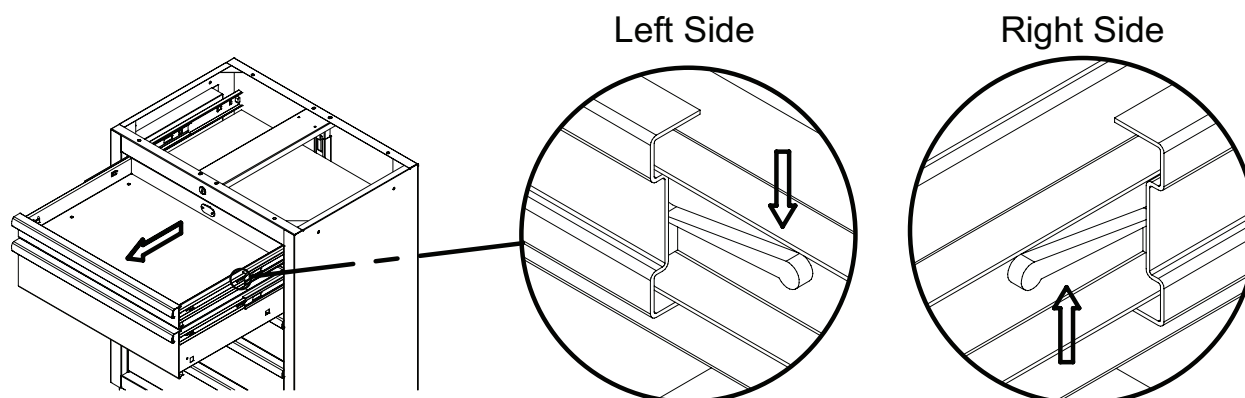

DRAWER OPERATION



Removing the Drawer

1. Empty the drawer before removal.
2. Fully extend the drawer until it reaches the end of its travel.
3. Locate the release lugs on both drawer slides.
4. Press both release lugs simultaneously as shown — one side presses down and the other side presses up.
5. While holding the release lugs, pull the drawer straight out to remove it from the cabinet.

Re-installing the Drawer

1. Fully extend both drawer slides from the cabinet.
2. Carefully align the drawer brackets/runners with the slides on both sides.
3. Insert the drawer evenly into the slides, ensuring both sides are correctly aligned and engaged.
4. Push the drawer completely closed. Firm pressure may be required on the first closure to fully engage the drawer slides and soft-close mechanism.
5. Open and close the drawer several times to confirm it moves smoothly, closes fully and is securely engaged on both sides.

IMPORTANT: Do not force the drawer if it does not slide smoothly. Remove it and check that both sides are correctly aligned before trying again.

MAINTENANCE

1. Drawer maintenance: Lubricate the slides semi-annually with high-quality bearing grease.
2. Periodically tighten all hardware.
3. Lubricate the lock with graphite annually.
