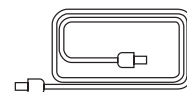

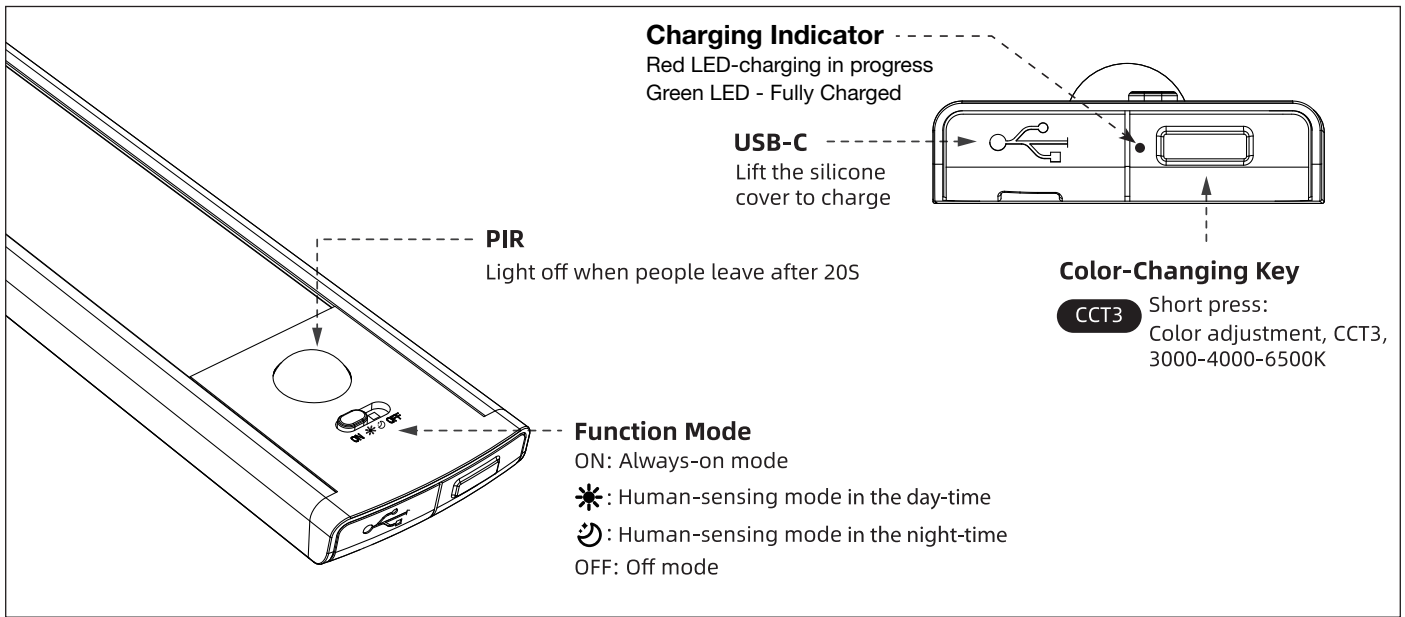

FUNCTION MODES

ON Mode - Light remains continuously ON until switched OFF or battery is depleted.

DAY SENSOR Mode - Light activates automatically when motion is detected in bright environments.

NIGHT SENSOR MODE - Light activates automatically when motion is detected in dark environments.

OFF Mode - Power OFF

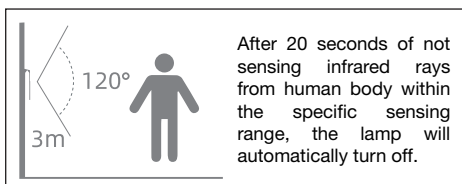
COLOUR TEMPERATURE

Press the CCT button to cycle through colour temperatures:

Warm White – 3000K

Natural White – 4000K

Cool White – 6500K



CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Open the silicone charging port cover.
2. Connect the USB Type-C cable to the charging port.
3. Connect the other end to a suitable 5V USB power source.
4. Allow the product to fully charge before first use.
5. Red LED-Charging in progress and Green LED- Fully charged

INSTALLATION DIAGRAM



Wipe the mounting surface clean.



Attach the blue side of the metal sheet to the magnet mark on the rear of the lamp



Tear off the white adhesive film on the metal sheet



Stick on the smooth surface
